- All media is welcome, 2-D work only. Please spray fixative on charcoals and pastels.
- Please no stretched canvases or wood frames We will be unable to hang this artwork artwork as the display panels are made for lightweight work.
- Size restrictions of entries: 8"x10", 9"x12", 11"x14", 12"x18", 18" x 24".
- No need to matt the work! All artwork will be securely matted at Immaculate Heart Academy.
- Neat, high quality student work created within the calendar year should be submitted.
- Artwork must be original in thought, design, and execution.
- Artwork content must be appropriate for the school, community, and for young people. Artwork with questionable content will not be selected.
- Please make 3 copies of the student permission form. Attach the original one to the place one in the large envelope provided and keep one for your records.
- In the large envelope provided, place the following:
- o One copy of each student permission form
- $\circ$  One School inventory Form
- Label for each student's work.
